

NOTICE FOR POSTGRADUATE (MDS) COURSE COUNSELLING-2021

The Department of Medical Education & Research will conduct Common Counseling during the month of August/September, 2021 for filling-up of **50% State Quota PG (MDS) Degree seats in H.P. Govt. Dental College & Hospital Shimla & 50% State Quota and 50% Management Quota seats in private un-aided Dental Colleges** of the State, as per H.P. state merit drawn from NEET-MDS-2021 result by the Member Secretary-cum-Principal, H. P. Government Dental College & Hospital, Shimla(MDS) Counseling Committee. The prescribed Application Form-cum-Prospectus for PG(MDS) Common Counseling can be downloaded from the **websites of DME&R and Principal, H.P. Govt. Dental College & Hospital, Shimla, i.e. www.hpgdcshimla.org , www.hpmds.smartpad.in & www.hp.gov.in/hpdmer** w. e. f. **22-08-2021**. The Online application form should be completely filled in all respects. The fee of prospectus amounting to Rs.2500/-for General category Rs.1500/- for SC/ST/OBC/IRDP/BPL categories should be deposited through online in SBI account link mentioned on the website of the institution **on or before 30-8-2021** (up-to 11:59PM) where after no application shall be considered.

1. The complete Prospectus for the Counselling process is available on the College Website www.hpgdcshimla.org/, www.hpmds.smartpad.in/ and Directorate of Medical Education & Research, H.P. website www.hp.gov.in/hpdmer. Candidates are advised to refer to the same for any information and for applying for admission in MDS course.
2. As per MDS Regulation (1st amendment), 2017 notified by Dental Council of India with prior approval of MOH&FW, Govt. of India. Eligibility criteria for applying for 50% State Quota and 50% Management Quota PG (MDS) Centralized /Common Counseling is as under: -
 - i. General Category 50th percentile (ii) SC/ST/OBC 40th percentile (iii) Person with Disability 45th percentile
3. The candidate(s) found ineligible at any stage shall have no claim for admission or continuation of PG degree (MDS) course even if he /she has qualified the NEET-MDS-2021.
4. All desirous eligible candidates, Direct and In-service, (M.O. Dental) who fulfil the prescribed eligibility criteria and other conditions of the Prospectus may apply through online mode only by using **online website www.hpmds.smartpad.in** for seeking admission to MDS courses in different Dental Colleges situated in the State of Himachal Pradesh in the different specialties.
5. In-service GDO (M.O. Dental) candidates are also required to apply through online mode for seeking admission to MDS courses along-with "Service-cum-No Objection Certificate" from the competent authority..
6. Category once opted will not be changed.
7. Online Counseling for admission will be held as per the schedule in prospectus. **No separate intimation will be sent. However, candidates are advised to regularly stay in touch with the websites, regarding the important dates to identify the current status of Centralized /Common Counseling for admission.**
8. . All matters and disputes related to PG (MDS) counseling are subject to legal jurisdiction of courts in Shimla only.
